Professor Nii Odartei Mills, Ph.D. is president of the Santa Institute of Technology (SITE), in Dzorwulu, Accra, Ghana, and a consulting engineer. In addition, he is a Minister of the Gospel, a Traditional Ruler of the Trom Dynasty of Ngleshie Alata, Jamestown, Accra, a management consultant/lecturer, and a council member of the Jamestown Ngleshie Alata Paramount Stool.

Early in his career, in 1985, Dr. Mills was a mathematics tutor at the Ebenezer Secondary School. That was prior to his traveling to Havana Cuba to study electrical engineering. He returned to Ghana to work as an engineer at the Volta River Authority.

In 1992, he joined the National Industrial Company Limited as a plant engineer. He subsequently worked as an electrical engineer at the Electricity Company of Ghana.

He completed the MBA Finance option at the University of Ghana, in 2001, and joined the Ghana Broadcasting Corporation, as director of engineering.

In 2006, he left the private sector, launching a career in academia, teaching at All Nations University, the Accra Institute of Technology and Methodist University, several other higher education institutions.

Dr. Mills has served on a number of boards in Ghana and abroad. He is a former chairman of the development planning committee of Ga West Municipal Assembly and a former president of the Okasa Heyeli Association.

He is married to Monica Amy Mills, and has three adult children: two daughters Naa Lamiley and Naa Lamiokor, and a son, Nii Lante. ■
