

The Honorable Dr. Mark Kurt Nawaane

Born in Kongo, Bolgatanga, in Ghana's Upper East Region, the Honorable Dr. Mark Kurt Nawaane was elected Member of Parliament of the Nabdam Constituency, in 2016.

Devoted to health care, healthcare management, and community development, he has been owner and chief executive officer of St. Mark Hospital-Wassa Akropong; and St. Mark Hospital-Dunkwa.

Among his various community and philanthropic activities have been the construction of a \$25,000 culvert at Yakote Bridge, to assist the inhabitants; the construction of a football stadium that is used by several clubs at Dunkwa-Offin; the construction of a market shed for the use of residents at Atechem, a suburb of Dunkea-Offin; and the construction of a recovery ward for the Kyekywere Clinic.

His extensive education includes a Masters in Business Administration, from the Paris Graduate School of Management; an MD, from the Institute of Medicine and Hygiene, in St. Petersburg, Russia; and a Certificate in Minilaparotomy, from the Norplant Insertion Centre, in Cape Coast. He is fluent in English, Russian, Twi and Frafra.

In addition, Dr. Nawaane has been enstooled as Nkouhene of the Denkyria Traditional Council.

Dr. Nawaane is married with four children. ■
